ORDER NO. 69

The Competent Authority is pleased to accept the request of the following Class-IV/Group-C Officials received through their concerned department for cancellation of their promotion order to the post of Grade IV (DASS)/Junior Assistant. Accordingly, the promotion orders in respect of the following officials, issued vide this department Order No. 55 & 67 dated 18.05.2016 & 29.06.2018 respectively are, hereby, stand cancelled retrospectively.

The above officials shall not be considered for promotion for next one year for the post of Gr.IV (DASS)/Junior Assistant from the date of cancellation of promotion order as per DOP&T, Govt. of India O.M No. 1/3/69-Estt(D) dated 22.11.1975 & No. 22034/3/81-Estt(D) dated 01.10.1981 states that:-

*"When a Government employee does not want to accept the promotion, which is offered to him, he may make a written request that he may not be promoted and the request will be considered by the appointing authority, stating relevant aspects into consideration. If the reason adduced for refusal of promotion are acceptable to the appointing authority, the next person in the select list may be promoted. However, since it may not be administratively possible or desirable to offer appointment to the persons who initially refused promotion on every occasion on which vacancy arises, during the period of validity of the panel, no fresh offer of appointment on promotion shall be made in such cases for a period of one year from the date of refusal of the first promotion or till a next vacancy arises, whichever is later. On the eventual promotion to the higher grade, such Government servant will loss seniority vis-à-vis his juniors promoted to the higher grade earlier irrespective of the fact whether the post in question are filled by selection or otherwise. The above mentioned policy will not apply where ad-hoc promotions against short term vacancies are refused"*

The above officials shall also not be eligible for further financial up-gradation till they agrees to be considered for promotion again and the second the next financial up-gradation shall also be deferred to the extent of period of debarment due to the refusal of promotion as per DOP&T O.M No. 35034/3/2008-Estt(D) dated 19.05.2009.

*"If a regular promotion has been offered but was refused by the employee before becoming entitled to a financial up gradation, no financial up gradation shall be allowed and as such an employee has not been stagnated due to lack of opportunities. If, however, financial up gradation has been allowed due to stagnation and the employees subsequently refuse the promotion, it shall not be a ground to withdraw the financial up gradation. He shall, however not be eligible to be considered for further financial up gradation till he agrees to be considered for promotion again and the second the next financial up gradation shall also be deferred to the extent of period of debarment due to the refusal"*
