Subject: Transfer/Posting of IAS/IPS officers of joint AGMUT cadre - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's Order No. 15041/02/2024-UTS.I dated 05.05.2025 and Order No. 15041/05/2023-UTS.I dated 16.05.2025 (copies enclosed) on the subject cited above and to say that several IAS/IPS officers who were transferred to various segments of the cadre have not been relieved till date to enable them to take up their new assignments.

2. In this context, it is stated that Para 9(viii) of the Guidelines for Transfer/Posting of IAS/IPS officers of AGMUT cadre, 2016 stipulates that officers under transfer shall be relieved to join their new segment within 15 days from the effective date of transfer. Should non-compliance of transfer orders persist, the officer would be liable to incur several consequences under the service rules, such as stoppage of salary, issuance of displeasure, debarment from promotion/Central Deputation etc.

3. It may, therefore, be ensured that the IAS/IPS officers of the AGMUT cadre, who have not been relieved till date and whose representations for cancellation of their transfer order or for keeping the transfer order in abeyance have not been acceded to by the Competent Authority, are relieved **within 05 working days** of issue of this letter to enable them to take up their new assignments.
