Subject: Implementation of Unified Pension Scheme for All India Services officers.

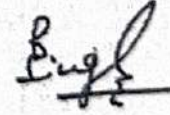
Sir/Madam,

The Department of Financial Services (DFS), vide Notification No.FX-1/3/2024- PR dated 24.01.2025, has notified the implementation of the Unified Pension Scheme (UPS), as an option under the National Pension System (NPS), with effect from 01.04.2025. The UPS has been operationalised by the PFRDA (Operationalisation of UPS under NPS) Regulations, 2025, issued by the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA) on 19.03.2025.

2. This Department vide letter of even number dated 30.04.2025 has informed the State/UT Governments that the UPS provides a defined benefit contributory pension framework for Central Government employees, including All India Services (AIS) officers. The Scheme is designed to provide sustainable and predictable retirement income to government employees, incorporating systematic contributions, default mechanisms, and post-retirement payout arrangements. The State/UT Governments were requested to ensure prompt onboarding of eligible AIS officers who opt for UPS as an option under NPS.

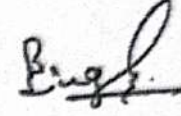
3. For the eligible AIS officers who opt for UPS as an option under NPS, the contribution to the Pool corpus, presently at 8.5% of Basic Pay and DA, on aggregate basis, shall be made by the Central Government into the Central Government Pool account. The contribution into the officer's Individual Corpus (presently at 10% by the employee and employer each) shall continue to be made by the employer of the officer as is the practice in NPS. At the time of retirement or exit, the amount in the officer's individual corpus, after applicable adjustments, shall be transferred to the Central Government Pool account. The admissible assured payout to the AIS officer shall be made from this central pool account.

4. A one-time, one-way switch facility from UPS to NPS shall be made available to all the AIS officers who have opted for UPS, as per the provisions in DFS O.M. No.1/3/2024-PR dated 25.08.2025.



5. The State/UT Governments are requested to ensure that AIS officers who wish to opt for the UPS under NPS submit their requests by 30.09.2025, or within such extended timelines, if any, allowed by the Central Government, as per the SOP available on the CRA website.

6. All State/UT Governments are further requested to circulate these instructions to all concerned authorities for necessary compliance.
