To,**All Addl. Chief Secretaries/Principal Secretaries/Secretaries/HODs, GNCT of Delhi.****Sub: Regarding review of posting of officers/officials of GNCTDSS Cadre on diverted capacity.**

Sir/Madam,

With reference to this department's letter dated 16.03.2026 on the subject cited above, I am directed to inform that the issue of posting of officers/officials of DSS Cadre on diverted capacity in various department of GNCTD is under consideration for review in this department.

Further, vide the above mentioned letter dated 16.03.2026 it was informed that Services Department has the mandate to provide DSS Cadre officers/officials to various departments of GNCTD as per their sanctioned posts vis-à-vis availability of officers/officials in different grades. However, it has been observed that some of the departments of GNCTD are functioning without having the required sanctioned strength of officers/officials in different grades, though, their functioning / work is emergent in nature and inevitable. Moreover, there is a huge shortage of staff in all grades of DSS Cadre, as such, Services Department is unable to post the officials to each department on full strength.

This constraint compels this department to provide the requisite number of officers/officials to various departments of GNCTD in diverted capacity over and above the sanctioned strength. Further, Services Department has to post such officers/officials in other departments for pay purpose only where major number of vacancies is available. This diversion not only affects badly the day-to-day functioning of the parent departments but also cause harassment to the officials as they have to visit their parent departments for submission of medical bills, TA bills, Children Education Allowance, Income Tax documents, etc.. In short, this leads to operational insufficiencies, employee dissatisfaction and governance issue.

To resolve this issue, it is required to create adequate number of posts at different levels in all the departments of GNCT of Delhi who is functioning without sanctioned strength or having less number of sanctioned strength in different grades, in comparison to their functional requirement. This process will not only restrict the diverted culture & streamline the posting of DSS cadre officials but also pave way for future recruitment/employment.

A list of the officers/officials working on diverted capacity in each of the departments was also provided separately vide this department's letter dated 17.03.2026 for information. Accordingly, it was requested to assess the functional requirement of the officers/officials at

various stages/grades vis-à-vis the sanctioned posts in different grades and submit a detailed proposal in Administrative Reforms Department, GNCTD with the request to carry out work study for creation of additional post, if any, to avoid requirement of officers/official at any level in diverted capacity. It was also requested to complete this exercise within a period of three months, failing which, excess staff would be withdrawn and such department(s) will have to function with the officers/official posted there against the sanctioned posts only.

A period of more than a month has passed and only a few departments have initiated the process for creation of additional posts of DSS Cadre as per their functional requirements against the officers/officials posted in diverted capacity.

It is therefore, once again requested to look into the matter and direct the officer concerned to assess the functional requirement of the officers/officials at various stages/grades vis-à-vis the sanctioned posts in different grades and submit a detailed proposal in Administrative Reforms Department, GNCTD with the request to carry out work study for creation of additional post, if any, to avoid requirement of officers/official at any level in diverted capacity. An action taken report in the matter may also be sent to this department within a period of one week.
