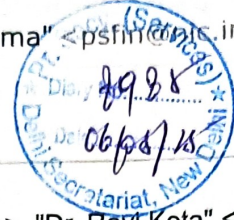

**Subject: Timely implementation of Unified Pension Scheme for All India Services officers.**

Sir/Madam,

The Department of Financial Services (DFS), vide Notification No.FX-1/3/2024-PR dated 24.01.2025, has notified the implementation of the Unified Pension Scheme (UPS) under the National Pension System (NPS), with effect from 01.04.2025. This is further supported by the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (Operationalisation of Unified Pension Scheme under National Pension System) Regulations, 2025, notified on 19.03.2025.

2. The UPS provides a defined benefit contributory pension framework for Central Government employees, including All India Services (AIS) officers. The scheme is designed with an Individual Corpus and a Pool Corpus, with specific contribution responsibilities for employees and the Government. For All India Service (AIS) officers opting for UPS, such contributions will be made by their respective States cadres. Notably, timely and full remittance of both employee and employer contributions is critical to achieving the benchmark corpus and ensuring the assured payout under UPS. Any delays or shortfalls in the remittance of contributions under NPS and UPS can severely impact the retirement benefits of the AIS officers.

3. Accordingly, all State Governments/UT Administrations are requested to:

- ensure prompt onboarding of eligible AIS officers who opt for UPS, in accordance with the prescribed timelines.
- ensure regular and timely remittance of employee and employer contributions under both NPS and UPS, as applicable.
- sensitize the concerned departments about the critical nature of compliance to avoid adverse financial implications for officers.

Your cooperation in the successful and smooth implementation of the UPS is highly solicited.
