2. To strengthen this objective, DEA has collaborated with AJNIFM, Faridabad to conduct six (6) offline training programs as detailed below:



The participants must have at least 3 years of exposure in the area of PPP/ Infra Sector planning/ execution/ Financing etc.

Workshop on Public Private Partnership (PPP) for Leadership level Officer	03 days	9 th to 11 th December, 2024	The workshop is tailored for senior officials, project managers, investors, financial analysts, and professionals from Central Govt. & State Government involved in infrastructure development and public service delivery. The participants must have completed around 14 years of service with at least 3 years of exposure in the area of PPP /Infra Sector planning/ execution/ Financing etc.
