Subject:- Online Knowledge Co-Creation Program for Young Leaders on "Sustainable Fisheries Development" from 4th to 21st November, 2022.

The Government of Japan has invited nominations for online training course on "Sustainable Fisheries Development" from 4th to 21st November, 2022 under the Technical Cooperation Programme with India. The course is intended for the national governmental orginastions (Ministry of Fisheries, Fisheries Agency, boards of fisheries resources, skipjackrelated agencies, municipalities, etc.) especially dealing with skipjack resources issues and the local government authorities or related organizations in charge of managing, protecting and administrating skipjack resources for sustainable development. The eligibility conditions and other information about the course are mentioned in the Information Booklet received from the sponsoring Government (Annex-I). Number of slots available for India is 7 regular candidate and 3 reserved candidate.





Gain insight to an essence of sustainable skipjack resources management through scientific approach and industrial promotion activities from the practice and experience of Japan.




Outline
