Respected Sir,

As you are aware, the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA) has the primary mandate to conduct Foundation Training for all officers of Group 'A' Central Services, besides Phase-I & Phase-II, Induction and MCTP Training of All IAS officers. In addition, the Academy is also conducting Common Mid Career Training Programme for all Group-A services at various stages of their career. In addition, it also conducts several other capacity building and training programmes across a spectrum of sectors. Officers of different Civil Services are trained in the Academy at both Induction and Mid Career levels.

The training programmes in the Academy - both Induction and In-service - are also focused on practical & experience-sharing and are coordinated by Joint/Deputy Directors who are on deputation from IAS, other All India Services and Central Services. In this context, the quality of training is largely dependent on having a capable team of JDs/DDs in the Academy. There is a need for officers who have been successful administrators in the field, and have the head & heart to inspire the young entrants to Civil Services. It will also be desirable to have a mixed team of Civil Servants in the Academy drawn from different Civil Services given the myriad of programmes conducted.

At present, there are eight vacancies of Deputy Directors (DDs) (Director and Deputy Secretary level) in the Academy which need to be filled up on priority. I may also mention that these positions are a part of Central Staffing Scheme and in order to further encourage the officers to opt for a stint at the Academy, Govt has afforded certain additional benefits too. The officers posted in the Academy are incentivized by a total central deputation tenure of 7.5 years, a training allowance of 24% of the basic pay, provided accommodation within the campus of the Academy and also given priority for nomination to long term foreign trainings sponsored by DoPT. It may be added that only half of the time spent in the Academy is counted towards the deputation tenure of five years (05) which also enables officers to do a stint in a Ministry / Department in Govt at Delhi etc. during the deputation period. Most importantly, officers posted in the Academy get a chance to interface with fresh minds and fresh thinking in a serene and enriching atmosphere. The exposure of rich practices through peer learning and guest faculty will add to the learnings and profile of the officers immensely.

It may also be mentioned that the Academy has a few vacant positions of Assistant Directors which are operational at Level 11/12. Eligible officers from organised services can also be considered for these posts as well.
