Subject: Appointment of DS/Directors working in the Ministries/Departments under Central Staffing Scheme (CSS) to Non-CSS posts in the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) on shift basis.

It is proposed to fill three vacancies of Deputy Secretary/Director level posts in the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) on shift basis. These posts are non-CSS posts to be filled through Civil Services Board procedure.

2. The officers who are working at DS/Director level in different Ministries/Departments under the Central Staffing Scheme are eligible to apply for these posts. If the officer is selected for the post, it will be treated as a 'shift' from a Central Staffing Scheme post to a non-Central Staffing Scheme post, which will entail additional tenure of two years as per the Consolidated Deputation Guidelines. The +2 option would be available only to those officers who were already working on a CSS post other than in the CVC. The additional tenure is subject to completion of two years on the present CSS post and availability of cadre clearance. In the absence of cadre clearance (for +2 tenure), the tenure will be restricted to the balance period of four/five years central deputation remaining to the officer. The maximum tenure admissible outside the cadre is seven years in both the stints CSS and non-CSS put together.
3. Dear Sir,

Chhattisgarh State Electricity Regulatory Commission (CSERC) has been reconstituted vide Energy Department Notification No. 1825/F1-2/2018/13/1/ED Naya Raipur dated 30th June 2018 by the Government of Chhattisgarh under Section (82) of the Electricity Act, 2003 (No. 36 of 2003).

Accordingly, the reconstituted Commission now consists of three members including the Chairperson of the Commission.

2. Hence, Department of Energy, Government of Chhattisgarh has constituted a selection committee vide its Order No.1827/F 1-7/13/1/चयन समिति/ऊवि/2007 नया रायपुर दिनांक 30 जून 2018 for selection of a panel of suitable candidates for the post of a Person of Law in Chhattisgarh State Electricity Regulatory Commission (CSERC).

3. As per the conclusion in para 114 of the Order dated 12.04.2018 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal Nos. 14697, 13451 of 2015 State of Gujarat and Others Vs. Utility Users' Welfare Association and Others, compliance to following is mandatory,

“i. Section 84(2) of the said Act is only an enabling provision to appoint a High Court Judge as a Chairperson of the State Commission of the said Act and it is not mandatory to do so.

ii. It is mandatory that there should be a person of law as a Member of the Commission, which requires a person, who is, or has been holding a judicial office or is a person possessing professional qualifications with substantial experience in the practice of law, who has the requisite qualifications to have been appointed as a Judge of the High Court or a District Judge.

iii. That in any adjudicatory function of the State Commission, it is mandatory for a member having the aforesaid legal expertise to be a member of the Bench.

iv. The challenge to the appointment of the Chairman and Member of the Tamil Nadu State Commission is rejected as also the suo moto proceedings carried out by the Commission.

v. Our judgment will apply prospectively and would not affect the orders already passed by the Commission from time to time.

vi. In case there is no member from law as a member of the Commission as required aforesaid in para 2 of our conclusion, the next vacancy arising in every State Commission shall be filled in by a Member of law in terms of Clause (ii) above."

4. The member to be appointed in compliance to the order dated 12.04.2018 passed by Hon'ble Supreme court of India shall hold the post for a term of five years from the date on which he/she enters upon office or till he/she attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier. Other terms and conditions of service would be as provided in the electricity Act, 2003. The member shall be entitled to pay level of 15 of seventh pay scale notified by Govt. of India plus other allowances as per rule. If the incumbent draws pension then he/she will be entitle to get the pay after deduction of the pension amount. The person so appointed shall not hold any other office. He/she shall have to resign or opt for voluntary retirement from the existing service, if any, to which he belongs, in case he has not attained the age of superannuation.

5. In view of the details in above paras I request you to propose the names of interested and suitable person for the vacant post of Member, Chhattisgarh State Electricity Regulatory Commission with headquarter at Raipur.

6. I shall be grateful if you could forward proposals of suitable persons for the post of Member have qualification and experience as prescribed in para 3 above so as to reach us by evening of **17th August 2018** . While forwarding proposals may kindly make sure that person proposed have not any financial or other interest which is likely to prejudice of his/her function as member, CSERC.



2.
