Sub.:- Regarding Medical examination of Grade-II(DASS)/ASO, Grade-IV(DASS)/Junior and Assistant Stenographer of GNCT of Delhi.

Sir/Madam,

Services Department, GNCT of Delhi vide letters dated 24.07.2019 and 19.08.2019 has clarified that colour blindness is not an impediment for the appointment to the post of Grade-II (DASS), Grade-IV(DASS) and Stenographers. However, departments of GNCT of Delhi are still forwarding references for clarification to Services Department on the subject matter.

In this context, this is once again reiterated that as per Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Notification No. 16-45/2010-DD.III dated 29.07.2013, the post of Head Clerk, Lower Division Clerk and Stenographer are identified posts for visually impaired candidates wherein Blind and Low Vision candidates are eligible. As such, colour blindness is not an impediment for the appointment to the post of Grade-II(DASS)/ASO, Grade-IV(DASS)/Junior Assistant and Stenographer in GNCT of Delhi.

It is, therefore, requested to inform the concerned Medical Board(s)/Hospital(s) of GNCT of Delhi while forwarding the request for medical examination of the candidate(s), about above mentioned clarifications, for appointment to the post of Grade-II (DASS)/ASO, Grade-IV (DASS)/Junior Assistant and Stenographer nominated by Services Department.
