Subject:- Singapore – Qatar Asia-Middle East Dialogue (AMED) Training Programme Course on "Public Policy and Administrative Reform" in Doha, Qatar from 28<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2019.

The Republic of Singapore has invited nominations for the above mentioned training programme to be held in Singapore under the Technical Assistance Programme with India. The programme is intended for mid-to-senior-level officials who are involved in public policy formulation and administrative reforms. The eligibility conditions and other information about the course are mentioned in the Information Brochure received from the sponsoring Government (Annex-I). Number of slots available for India is three.

- 2. Nomination of candidates is regulated by the guidelines prescribed by DEA, a synopsis of which is attached as Annex-II.

3. The local conveyance will be reimbursed restricted to the actual expenditure incurred or Rs. 500/- whichever is less (Rs. 350/- for Delhi & NCR).
