Appellate Tribunal and other Authorities (Qualifications. A Member shall hold office for a term of four years or till he attains the age of sixty-five years, whichever is earlier.

The terms and conditions of service of Members shall be governed by the provisions of "the Tribunal, Appellate Tribunal and other Authorities (Qualifications, Experience and other Conditions of Service of Members) Rules, 2020".

- Regarding the Qualifications & appointment of Members, Rule 3 of the Tribunal, 3. Appellate Tribunal and other Authorities (Qualifications, Experience and other Conditions of Service of Members) Rules, 2020 and the schedule attached thereto provides that-
- (b) A person shall not be qualified for appointment, as Administrative Member, unless he, -
