Lear Chief Secretary,

The Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) is an attached office of the Ministry of Culture, Government of India. Maintenance of ancient monuments and archaeological sites and remains of national importance is the prime concern of ASI. The organization has a large workforce of trained archaeologists, conservators, epigraphist, architects and scientists etc. to implement this mandate.

The posts in various cadres of ASI are filled through SSC and UPSC in accordance with their respect Recruitment Rules (RRs). RR for Group A posts allows these posts to be filled through deputation if suitable candidates are not found through other means of recruitment viz. promotion or direct recruitment. Calling people from state governments to join ASI on deputation often brings new perspective to the organization.

Recently cadres in ASI have been strengthened and a number of new posts including Group A posts have been created. These are to be filled up on urgent basis. In the past there have been instances where Group A posts which are to be filled through promotion had remained vacant due to lack of eligible candidates in their respective feeder cadres. Efforts to fill these posts through deputation sometimes also remained unsuccessful presumably due to lack of awareness about these vacancies.

I am enclosing a list of some of the vacant Group A posts along with their respective Recruitment Rules, which allows these posts to be filled through deputation. These posts will also soon be advertised on UPSC website and employment news.

I would like to request you to kindly get these posts circulated among relevant Departments, Educational Institutions under administrative control of the State Government.

I am of the opinion that this exercise will mutually benefit State Governments as well as ASI.
